### Uniform

### Seesaw

Please ensure that you have logged onto Seesaw, using the new QR code. If you are having trouble logging on, please speak with us.

### Show & Tell

We love hearing about children's **achievements** out of school, so please encourage your child to bring in any medal or certificates to show to the class. We also encourage children to bring in items from home which are **directly related to our learning**. You can also upload pictures on Seesaw for Show & Tell.

### "Points mean Prizes!

We will be continuing our rewards chart, where all the children will be earning points towards a prize. For every 20 points they earn through reading at home (please record this in their reading record book) and completing their homework, they will receive a prize.

### School Dinners

Please remember that your child is entitled to a free school dinner in Seahorse Class.

### Reading Books

Your child will be given a reading book aligned to their current Phonics level. Being able to read fluently is vital to your child's learning and we ask you to read at least 3 times each week and record this in their reading record book. Reading books will be reviewed and changed regularly.

### Phonics

Your child will be given a login for Reading Eggs, an App which helps to embed their Phonics. The App can be used on any device.

### Water bottles.

Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day. It will be sent home every day to be cleaned and replenished.

**The bottle must only contain water.**

### Library Books

We have library time on a Friday when the children are able to change their school library book. This is a book which is not related to their Phonics level and is intended to be a book which they can share with family members.
